



**THE WINTER CEREALS DEVELOPMENT PLAN REGULATIONS – REFUND OF
CHECK-OFFS**

Order No. 12/11. The SASKATCHEWAN WINTER CEREALS DEVELOPMENT COMMISSION, pursuant to the provisions of *The Winter Cereals Development Plan Regulations* and *The Agri-Food Act, 2004*, hereby determines and orders as follows:

- 1** A check-off refund request shall:
 - (a) be made in writing on a form that is provided by the Commission; and
 - (b) contain the following information:
 - (i) the producer's name, mailing address and telephone number;
 - (ii) the producer's Canadian Wheat Board identification number (if applicable);
 - (iii) the legal description of the land on which the winter cereals were produced; and
 - (iv) any specifics of the refund request.
- 2** The Commission shall accept, consider and verify all refund requests received at its head office within the time periods stated in subsection 24(1) of the Commission's governing regulations and shall provide the requesting producer with a refund of all check-off moneys to which he or she is entitled if all refund requirements are met.
- 3** Order No. 06/06 – Refund of Check-off is hereby wholly revoked.
- 4** This Order will remain in effect for a period no longer than ten years from the date this Order is approved by the Agri-Food Council.

Order No. 12/11 is made pursuant to clause 8(1)(h) and section 24 of *The Winter Cereals Development Plan Regulations* and shall be effective upon the date of this Order. By order of the Saskatchewan Winter Cereals Development Commission.
