THE WINTER CEREALS DEVELOPMENT PLAN REGULATIONS – REPORTING

Order No. 10/11. The SASKATCHEWAN WINTER CEREALS DEVELOPMENT COMMISSION, pursuant to the provisions of *The Winter Cereals Development Plan Regulations* and *The Agri-Food Act, 2004*, hereby determines and orders as follows:

1 A buyer shall:

- (a) record for each month the total volume of winter cereals acquired by the buyer from each producer; and
- (b) provide a report on the previous month's winter cereals records to the Commission by the twentieth of each month.


2 The Commission may request from a producer or a buyer the following information:

- (a) the amount of winter cereals grown by a producer or to which the producer is entitled to under a crop-share arrangement;
- (b) the amount of winter cereals marketed by a producer and the details of the marketing; and
- (c) any other general information relating to the production and marketing of winter cereals that the Commission requires to carry out the purposes of the Plan.

3 Order No. 04/06 – Reporting is hereby wholly revoked.


4 This Order will remain in effect for a period no longer than ten years from the date this Order is approved by the Agri-Food Council.

Order No. 10/11 is made pursuant to clause 8(1)(h) of *The Winter Cereals Development Plan Regulations* and shall be effective upon the date of this Order. By order of the Saskatchewan Winter Cereals Development Commission.
