## The Winter Cereals Development Plan Regulations

## ORDER 01/08 – GRAIN BROKERS, BUYERS AGENTS, SELLERS AGENTS & GRAIN DEALER REGISTRATION

The Saskatchewan Winter Cereals Development Commission, pursuant to the provisions of *The Winter Cereals Development Plan Regulations* and <u>The Agri-Food Act, 2004</u> hereby determines and orders that:

- 1. Each grain broker, buyer agent, sellers agent or grain dealer of winter cereals produced in Saskatchewan shall register with the Commission prior to August 1st of each year on a form provided by the Commission.
- 2. Each grain broker, buyers agent, sellers agent or grain dealer of winter cereals produced in Saskatchewan who acts to bring together buyers and sellers of designated winter cereals without taking ownership of the winter cereal, and subsequently charge either the buyer or seller of the regulated commodity a per tonne, per bushel, or per sale commission fee or surcharge for said services shall collect the applicable levy at the prescribed rate from the seller of the designated commodity.
- 3. Each grain broker, buyers agent, sellers agent or grain dealer of winter cereals produced in Saskatchewan shall supply the following information:
  - a. the name, telephone number and mailing address of the registrant;
  - b. the email address of the registrant (if applicable);
  - c. the address of the registrant if it is different from the mailing address:
  - d. the name(s), address(es) and telephone number(s) of the officers of grain broker, buyers agent, sellers agent or grain dealer.
  - e. the name(s), address(es) and telephone number(s) of any authorized agent(s) operating in Saskatchewan on behalf of the grain broker, buyers agent, sellers agent or grain dealer; and
  - f. such other information as the Commission may require.
- 3. This order will remain in effect for a period no longer than 10 years beyond the date this order is approved by the Council.

Order No. 01/08 is made pursuant to section 22 of *The Winter Cereals Development Plan Regulations* and shall be effective on, from and after the  $\chi \chi$  day of  $\chi \chi \chi$ , 2008. By order of the Saskatchewan Winter Cereals Development Commission.
